About the Scholarship

The scholarship is funded by the William R. Boone High School Foundation as part of its mission to support Boone students in their academic pursuits. The winner(s) receive the scholarship directly during the annual awards ceremony in the spring. The scholarship is for one academic year and is not renewable.

Eligibility

- The applicant must be a graduating senior of Boone High School.
- The applicant must have a GPA of 2.5 or better.
- The applicant has been accepted to a post-secondary school (college, university, trade school, private institution, etc.).
- The applicant can demonstrate financial need.

- Attach FAFSA Student Aid Report/Pell Grant eligibility.
